## **Current Events Weekly Assignment**

Go to Google News or another news source from the list provided and choose 3 headlines from the past week. Make sure you have at least one world news story and at least one story from somewhere in Canada.

For each headline:

- 1. Read the article or watch the video.
- 2. Find the same story from 1 or 2 other sources. If it's a world news story, try to find a source from that country.
- 3. On lined paper (neatly!):
  - Write today's date.
  - List your sources and the headlines they used.
  - Write a summary of the story. Remember to cover who, what, where, when and why in your summary.
  - Compare the sources. Do they present the information differently? Is there a bias?
- 4. Discuss your opinion of the story with an adult. Consider these questions before discussing:
  - Is this news important?
  - Is this good news or bad?
  - If it's bad, has it happened before? Can it be avoided?
  - What do you think the impact of this event will be on the people or places involved?
  - Does it affect you? How?
  - How does this news make you feel? What kind of emotions does it evoke? Do different sources evoke different emotions?
